



AMR90 High Performance Surround Sound Computer Speaker System



Positioning Your Speakers for Best Performance

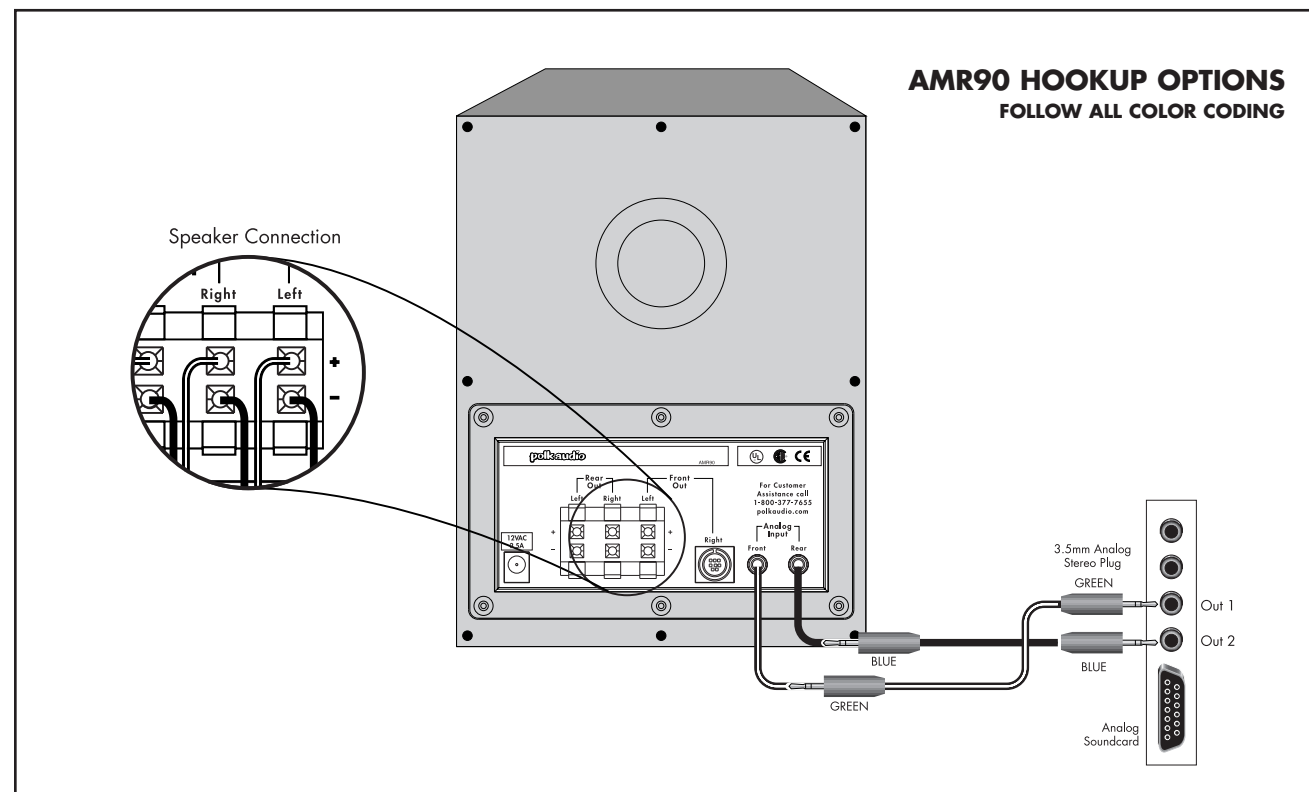
Placing the Subwoofer close to a wall or in a corner reinforces Subwoofer response.

AMR90: Position the four Satellite speakers around your usual sitting position: one speaker on each side of your computer monitor, and two rear Satellites behind you. The rear surround speakers come with brackets for wall mounting.

Adjusting and Setting Volume

Amplification for the AMR is in the Subwoofer. Select the setting at which there is the perfect amount of bass response for your taste:

- Turn the system ON using the Master Power switch on the Subwoofer.
- Turn the on/off, volume knob to ON on the right Satellite speaker.
- Using a music CD, set the subwoofer volume with the Subwoofer Volume knob.

To allow Polk Audio to offer the best possible warranty service, please fill out the Product Registration Card(s) and send it to the Factory, at the address provided on the Product Cards(s) within ten (10) days of the date of purchase.

Defective Products must be shipped, together with proof of purchase, prepaid insured to the Polk Audio Authorized Dealer from whom you purchased the Product, or to the Factory at 2550 Britannia Boulevard, Suite D, San Diego, California 92173. Products must be shipped in the original shipping container or its equivalent; in any case the risk of loss or damage in transit is to be borne by you.

If upon examination at the Factory or Polk Audio Authorized Dealer it is determined that the unit was defective in materials or workmanship at any time during this Warranty period, Polk Audio or the Polk Audio Authorized Dealer will, at its option, repair or replace this Product at no additional charge, except as set forth below. All replaced parts and Products become the property of Polk Audio. Products replaced or repaired under this warranty will be returned to you, within a reasonable time, freight prepaid.

This warranty does not include service or parts to repair damage caused by accident, disaster, misuse, abuse, negligence, inadequate packing or shipping procedures, commercial use, voltage inputs in excess of the rated maximum of the unit, cosmetic appearance of cabinetry not directly attributable to

- Once this position is set, you can then use the Volume Control located on the right Satellite to adjust system volume and turn the system on and off.
- Set the front/rear balance with the Fader knob (located behind the volume control) on the Right Satellite speaker.

Troubleshooting

Weak sound, no sound, bad sound?

- Is the Green LED light (located on the right Satellite speaker) ON? Make sure the speakers are connected to the AC adapter and the power button is pressed ON.
- Is there output from the soundcard? Connect the speakers to an alternate audio source, such as the headphone jack of a CD player or radio. If the speakers produce sound, the problem is probably with your soundcard. Recheck your soundcard installation and setup procedure. Consult the soundcard's manual.
- Check the "mute" and "volume" controls on your soundcard or media player software and keyboard.
- Are the speakers connected properly? Make sure the plugs are securely connected in the proper location according to their colorcoding and the diagram on the front of this manual. Make sure the speaker wires with the white stripes are connected to the (+) speaker terminals on the subwoofer.

Safety Warning: Electrical equipment may be hazardous if misused. An adult must always supervise operation of this product. Use only the AC adapter specifically designed for your AMR System. Polk Audio, Inc cannot be responsible for damage caused by other AC adapters. Protect speakers from dampness and liquids.
