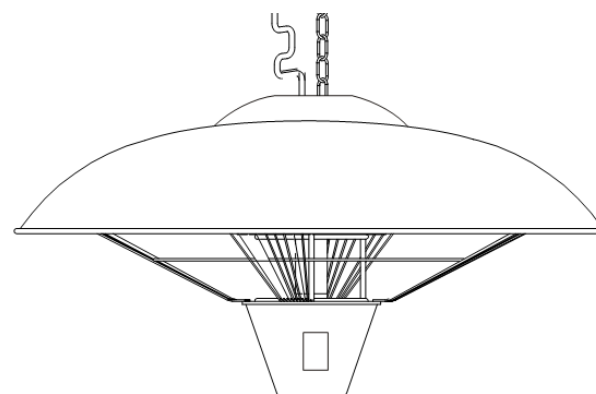




Hanging Electric Patio Heater

INSTRUCTION MANUAL

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS:

When using this electric unit, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock and/or injury.

1. Read ALL instructions before using this unit.
2. CAUTION: Risk of Electric Shock. DO NOT open or try to repair the heater yourself.
3. This heater may get hot when in use. To avoid burns, DO NOT let bare skin touch hot surfaces.
4. Keep combustible materials, such as furniture, pillows, bedding, paper, clothes, and curtains at least 3 ft from the front of the heater and keep them away from the sides, top, and rear. DO NOT place towels or other objects on the heater.
5. Extreme caution is necessary when any heater is used by or near children or the disabled. Do not leave the heater unattended while in operation.
6. DO NOT operate any heater with a damaged cord or after the heater malfunctions, has been dropped or has been damaged in any manner, Return heater to authorized service examination, electrical or mechanical adjustment, or repair.
7. This heater is not intended for use in bathrooms, laundry areas and similar indoor locations. Never locate heater where it may fall into a bathtub or other water container. To protect against electrical hazards, DO NOT immerse in water or other liquids.
8. DO NOT touch the control panel or plug in with wet hands.
9. DO NOT run cord under carpeting. DO NOT cover cord with throw rugs, runners, or similar coverings. Arrange cord away from traffic area and where it will not be tripped over.
10. DO NOT insert or allow foreign objects to enter any ventilation or exhaust opening as this may cause an electric shock or fire, or damage the heater.
11. To prevent a possible fire, DO NOT block the air intakes or exhaust in any manner, DO NOT use on soft surfaces, like a bed, where openings may become blocked.
12. A heater has hot and arcing or sparking parts inside. DO NOT use in areas where gasoline, or other flammable materials are present.
13. The heater is not intended for use with an extension cord. Plug the cord directly into an appropriate wall receptacle. If an extension cord is used, it must be a minimum 14 AWG and rated not less than 1875 watts

17. Use only for intended household use as described in this manual. Any other use not recommended by the manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock, or injury to persons. The use of attachments not recommended or sold by unauthorized dealers may cause hazards.
18. DO NOT attempt to repair or adjust any electrical or mechanical functions on this unit, doing so will void your warranty, The inside of the unit contains no user serviceable parts. Only qualified personnel should perform all servicing only.
19. Connect to properly grounded outlets only.
20. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

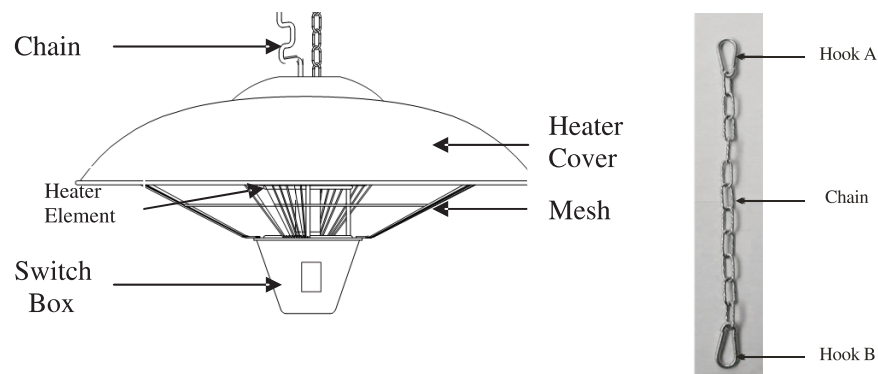

PRODUCT DIAGRAM

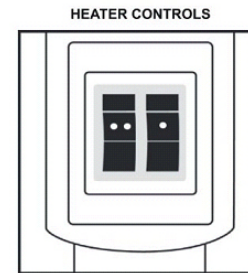


OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This electric halogen patio heater is equipped with 3 heating settings: low, Medium and High

- To operate the heater on low, press the red switch on the right. This switch will have a single white dot near the tip. Once the low switch is pressed, the smaller bottom heating element will glow and radiate heat.
- To operate the heater on Medium, press the red switch on the left. This switch will have two white dots near the top. Once the medium switch is pressed. The larger top heating element will glow and radiate heat

- To operate the heater on High, press both the low and medium red switches. This will cause both the bottom and top heating elements to glow and radiate heat.



MAINTENANCE

Unplug the unit and let it cool completely.

- To keep this unit clean, the outer shell may be cleaned with a soft, damp cloth. You may use a mild detergent if necessary. After cleaning, dry the unit with a soft cloth.
- DO NOT use alcohol, gasoline, abrasive powders, furniture polish, or rough brushes to clean the heater. This may cause damage or deterioration to the surface of the heater.
- Although this heater is outdoor approved, DO NOT immerse the heater in water for your safety.

Wait until the unit is completely dry before use.

STORAGE

When not in use, store this unit in a cool, dry location. To prevent dust and dirt build-up, use the original packaging to repack this unit.

TROUBLE SHOOTING

If this unit does not operate properly, please check the following before repair or service:

- Check if the power cord is plugged into an electrical outlet, if not, plug in.
- Check if electricity to the main fuse is working.
- Make certain the power switches are turned on. If not, choose a setting.
