## Setting up the XC720xd

Before you deploy virtual desktops, complete the following tasks to set up your appliance:

1. Cable the network ports of the host system for the following connections:
  - a. Broker and virtual desktops
  - b. Hypervisor and host server
  - c. Integrated Dell Remote Access Controller (iDRAC)
2. Configure the hypervisor on the host system.
3. Configure Nutanix software.
4. Install and configure Microsoft SQL Server.
5. Install and configure Microsoft SCVMM software if using vWorkspace with Hyper-V or XenDesktop with Hyper-V.
6. Install and configure VMware vCenter if using VMware View or XenDesktop with vSphere.
7. Install and configure connection broker as necessary.
